In July 2018 Ann Jangle, together with her dog Kevin, sold everything she owned aside from a bag of clothes & her guitar & decided it was time to give back. Using her musical abilities to uplift communities & most importantly raise awareness for dogs. Kevin rescued Ann more than she did him, sparking off another incredible journey.



Since then Ann Jangle has played music in every province in aid of animal awareness across South Africa, gathered over 3 tons of dog food for different animal shelters, built dog kennels in Mpumalanga, volunteered at Sterilization days across Zululand, Raised money for deworming medication for dogs in rural areas spreading over 24 000kms & has been living in a tent through out most parts.



Her work with domestic animals has since grown into a love for wildlife & after much research Ann has decided to now cycle from Botswana to Kenya to raise awareness for the Endangered African Wild dog, at the same time leaving no carbon footprint.

Her cycling journey started on 11 June (her birthday) at the Ramotswa Border Post, Botswana.

"AFRICAN DREAM PARADE" is the name of her solo Album and also the tour she has been on since last year July. Album sales contribute 100% to sustaining Ann throughout Africa as she will have no income while cycling.

During this cycling trip Ann is volunteering at many wildlife organisations and joined forces with KALAHARI RESEARCH & CONSERVATION who mainly focus on Wild Dogs & Vultures.

P.S. Kevin & her latest member to the family, Kezzy, will stay with Ann's closest companion in Muizemberg, Cape Town on a big property & get all the love & nature hikes they are so used to.

For now, this is something that needs to be done to help animals.

Together with her 1kg tent, sleeping bag, gas burner, Martin Mini travel Guitar sponsored by Chris from Bushmans River, Eastern Cape & bicycle sponsored by Matthew De Jongh in Centurion, Ann will cycle from Ramotswa Border Post, Botswana, to Kalifi Festival in Kenya BUT SHE NEEDS YOUR HELP!

ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW

1. WHAT IS THE "AFRICAN DREAM PARADE" ?

AFRICAN DREAM PARADE is a journey with many legs. The first leg started in July in Johannesburg & ended in Cape Town playing music to gather dog food and finances to help smaller animal welfare organisations who don't get a lot of attention through playing music.



2. WHAT IS THE VISION?

Ann Jangle is cycling to Kenya from Botswana, woman alone on a bicycle, to raise awareness for endangered wildlife, particularly, the African Wild Dog (Also known as the painted hunting dog, painted wolf, African hunting dog, Cape hunting dog or African painted dog, is a canid native to sub-Saharan Africa).

On this journey she hopes to find an organisation, who dedicate their lives to saving these animals, to donate funds to. What better way to find this organisation than to physically go there and have a look.....

Ann will also be playing music, collaborating with different local musicians as a way of networking & enjoyment. The world will come together through music.

3. GOAL?

Consistent income through sponsorships & donations to keep Ann going, to educate fellow Africans on the importance of wildlife, the environment. This relationship directly affects the relationship with self.

4. WHY ANN?

"I'm 33 years old, I'm not married, I don't have kids, I am a born adventurer, I LOVE animals & I have been involved with community projects from Mozambique to Zimbabwe on & off since the age of 19.
